

ARMY EMERGENCY RELIEF

Army Emergency Relief (AER) assists Soldiers and their Families in times of financial need. AER can help Soldiers and their Families (with sponsor approval) Retirees, Widows and orphans of deceased Soldiers, and Reserve Component Soldiers on active duty for 30 days or more.

AER maybe able to assist with:

- Rent
- Utilities
- Food
- Clothing
- Emergency travel
- Emergency POV repair
- Funeral expenses
- Emergency medical or dental expenses
- Non-receipt of Pay/Lost or Stolen Funds
- Fire and other Disasters

Applying for assistance:

Make an appointment by calling 732-532-2077.

Soldiers requiring emergency travel will need the following documentation:

- DA 1103, Application for Army Emergency Relief Financial Assistance(the application must be signed by the commander or XO for approval)
- Approved orders for emergency leave or regular leave under emergency conditions
- American Red Cross verification of death/illness

Spouses geographically separated from the service member should obtain a Power of Attorney allowing spouse to receive AER Assistance and sign allotment.
