LOCKER FEES

\$35.00 for the season; \$15.00 for second locker.

No gasoline or oil storage is permitted in these lockers. All lockers must be vacated by October 30.



OPERATING & SURVIVAL TIPS

Check your fuel level frequently.

Do not operate near swimming areas.

If swamped or capsized, stay with boat.

Observe all speed and no wake signs.

Water skiing or towing other boats not permitted.

Sailboats & rowboats have the right of way.

DWI offenders will suffer heavy fines and personal risk.

Children under twelve years of age should wear life-jackets when on the docks or boat at all times.

Always render assistance to other boats in distress.

Do not maneuver thru heavy wakes in a head-on posture.

Always try for a forty-five degree angle to lessen the severity of the encounter.

RED FLAGS

The following activities are

PROHIBITED

at this Marina and its vicinity:

- * Draining or Disposal of Antifreeze
- * Draining or Disposal of Oil, Transmission Fluid or Other Fluids
- * Disposal of Hazardous Materials
- * Disposal of Trash
- * Smoking on the dock, near fuel or other highly combustible materials

Rules

The Fort Monmouth Marina conforms to the requirements of the Army's Environmental Management System (EMS). It is our policy to prevent pollution and minimize the impact of marina operations on our natural resources. We encourage those who participate in and enjoy recreational opportunities on the water to help us achieve these goals. Do not dispose of your trash in the water. There are containers located on Marina property for trash disposal. Due to mandatory recycling programs in New Jersey, containers are appropriately labeled for boaters' ease in the disposing of their trash.

Do not discharge oil or oily waste in the water. We are especially concerned about the quality of our water and require that all boaters comply.

Smoking is prohibited on the dock area or near any containers indicating the presence of fuel or other highly combustible material.

Working on your boat or trailer? Everyone on Marina property is required to use environmentally safe materials in cleaning, maintaining and/or repairing boats and/or trailers. Please dispose of all materials carefully.

Access Gate ALL PRIVATE BOAT SLIP PATRONS MUST SECURE THE FACILITY UPON ENTRY AND EXIT WHEN THE FACILITY IS NOT OPERATIONAL.
